## Hunt for New Recruits Gets Extension

Application deadline extended to Friday, March 28, 2014 in volunteer search for 2014-15 Civil Grand Jury.

SAN JOSE, Calif. (March 3, 2014): the Superior Court of California, County of Santa Clara's Presiding Judge, Hon. Brian C. Walsh, has announced that the filing deadline for the 2014-15 Civil Grand Jury has been extended to Friday, March 28, 2014, at 5:00 P.M. The Court is seeking volunteers for the one-year term who are committed to upholding the efficiency and integrity of local government.

The Civil Grand Jury is empowered to inspect and audit the books, records, and financial expenditures of all aspects of county and city government and special/school districts. The Civil Grand Jury also has the power to inspect jails and juvenile detention facilities. Recent reports have evaluated oversight of food truck operations and farmers markets, law enforcement public complaint procedures, as well as school district pay practices.

Applicants must be 18 years of age or older, United States citizens, and residents of Santa Clara County. The one-year term will begin on June 19, 2014. The time commitment is approximately 20-25 hours per week, or as determined by the Grand Jury.
