2026-2027 Civil Grand Jury Demographic Data

Summary: The Court received 92 new applications to serve on the 2026-2027 Civil Grand Jury. Of those, one individual was not qualified to serve and has been omitted from the data below pursuant to California Rule of Court 10.625(a)(4).

One individual from the 2025-2026 Civil Grand Jury and one alternate from the 2025-2026 Civil Grand Jury were nominated by the judicial officers of the Superior Court to serve as prospective regular grand jurors. These carry-over jurors were included in the data below according to California Rule of Court 10.625(b)(2).

Of the 93 prospective regular grand jurors, three individuals served one previous term as a civil grand juror in Santa Clara County and one individual served two previous terms as a civil grand juror in Santa Clara County. In addition, one individual served one term as an alternate in Santa Clara County and one individual served as an alternate for another jurisdiction in the past.
