# City of Campbell Response to Finding/Recommendations:

#### Finding 1:

The Campbell Police Department makes their complaint procedure available only in hard copy form in their lobby.

**Response:** The City of Campbell agrees with the finding.

## Recommendation 1a:

The Campbell Police Department should make their complaint procedure available on-line. In July 2013, the Campbell Police Department made our complaint procedure available on-line in both English and Spanish

#### Recommendation 1b:

The Campbell Police Department should make a complaint form available on-line and also freely available in hard copy in their lobby. In July 2013, the Campbell Police Department created an area in our lobby for a hard copy complaint form to be kept so members of the public can freely access the form. Also, the complaint form was made available on-line in both English and Spanish.

# Finding 2:

The Campbell Police Department makes their complaint procedure available only in English.

Response: The City of Campbell does not agree with the finding. The Campbell Police Department makes their complaint procedure available in Spanish as well as English.

## Recommendation 2:

The Campbell Police Department should make multilingual complaint materials available online and also freely available in hard copy form in their lobby. In July 2013, the Campbell Police Department made their complaint procedure and complaint form available on-line and in hard copy form in our lobby (see above recommendations).
