- Disputes with debt settlement companies
- Car sales, financing, repossession
- Disputes relating to towing of vehicles
- Door-to-door sales
- Home improvement contract issues (including solar panel issues)
- Credit reporting issues
- Dealing with default judgments obtained by sewer services
- Identity theft
- Co-signer issues
