	Note: You can mail the forms and fill out form FL-141 yourself. You do <u>not</u> have to get someone else to mail them for you. If you do not have the other party's current address, you may use their latest known address.
	If the Summons and Petition were served by publication or posting, you are not required to complete the Mandatory Financial Disclosures.

#### WHAT IS FINANCIAL DISCLOSURE?

In divorce and legal separation cases, California law (Family Code §2103) requires the parties to provide information to each other about their income and expenses, as well as their debts (even if you do not have any!). This is called financial disclosure. The first disclosure is called "Preliminary Declaration of Disclosure" (Family Code §2104) and is mandatory. The final disclosure, called "Final Declaration of Disclosure", may be waived by the parties (Family Code §2105).

#### DO I HAVE TO DO THIS?

Yes. This rule applies to almost all cases even if the parties do not have any assets or debts. You cannot get a final *Judgment* without completing the disclosure requirements. There are two exceptions to this rule:

- a. If you have a court order from the Judge that allows you serve by publication or posting.
- b. If you have filed a Summons/Petition for Nullity only and have not asked for a divorce in the alternative.

In these two instances only, you do not have to complete the disclosure process.

How to fill out, file and serve the Preliminary Declaration of Disclosure forms required in divorce, legal separation and nullity cases

#### What is a Preliminary Declaration of Disclosure (PDD)?

In divorce, legal separation and certain nullity cases, California law (Family Code §2103) requires the parties to provide information to each other about their income and expenses, as well as their debts (even if you do not have any!). This is called financial disclosure. The first disclosure is called "Preliminary Declaration of Disclosure" (Family Code §2104) and is mandatory.

#### You have to do this even if you do not have any assets or debts.

You cannot get a final *Judgment* without completing the disclosure requirements.

#### What to have with you when viewing the presentation:

- Completed forms: If you do not already have the forms, download these forms from the Court's website (www.scscourt.org).
  - o FL-140 Declaration of Disclosure
  - o FL-150 Income and Expense Declaration
  - FL-160 Property Declaration (You will need to complete two of these forms, one for separate property and one for community property)
- **Proof of Income:** Have proof of income (example: paystubs for the last two months, profit and loss statement etc).
- Tax Returns: Have your income tax returns for the past two years.
- **Have an interpreter.** If you do not speak, read or write English well, have an adult friend or relative who can read and write in English fluently *and* your language to help you.

#### INFORMATION AND INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING FORM FL-160

Property Declaration (form FL-160) is a multipurpose form, which may be filed with the court as an attachment to a Petition or Response or served on the other party to comply with disclosure requirements in place of a Schedule of Assets and Debts (form FL-142). Courts may also require a party to file a Property Declaration as an attachment to a Request to Enter Default (form FL-165) or Judgment (form FL-180).

When filing a Property Declaration with the court, do not include private financial documents listed below.

#### Identify the type of declaration completed

- 1. Check "Community and Quasi-Community Property Declaration" on page 1 to use *Property Declaration* (form FL-160) to provide a combined list of community and quasi-community property assets and debts. Quasi-community property is property you own outside of California that would be community property if it were located in California.
- 2. Do not combine a separate property declaration with a community and quasi-community property declaration. Check "Separate Property Declaration" on page 1 when using *Property Declaration* to provide a list of separate property assets and debts.

#### **Description of the Property Declaration chart**

#### Pages 1 and 2

- 1. Column A is used to provide a brief description of each item of separate or community or quasi-community property.
- 2. Column B is used to list the date the item was acquired.
- 3. Column C is used to list the item's gross fair market value (an estimate of the amount of money you could get if you sold the item to another person through an advertisement).
- 4. Column D is used to list the amount owed on the item.
- 5. Column E is used to indicate the net fair market value of each item. The net fair market value is calculated by subtracting the dollar amount in column D from the amount in column C ("C minus D").
- 6. Column F is used to show a proposal on how to divide (or confirm) the item described in column A. Page 3
- 1. Column A is used to provide a brief description of each separate or community or quasi-community property debt.
- 2. Column B is used to list the date the debt was acquired.
- 3. Column C is used to list the total amount of money owed on the debt.
- 4. Column D is used to show a proposal on how to divide (or confirm) the item of debt described in column A.

#### When using this form only as an attachment to a *Petition* or *Response*

- 1. Attach a Separate Property Declaration (form FL-160) to respond to item 9. Only columns A and F on pages 1 and 2 and columns A and D on page 3 are required.
- 2. Attach a Community or Quasi-Community Declaration (form FL-160) to respond to item 10, and complete column A on all pages.

#### When serving this form on the other party as an attachment to Declaration of Disclosure (form FL-140)

- 1. Complete columns A through E on pages 1 and 2, and columns A through C on page 3.
- 2. Copies of the following documents must be attached and served on the other party:
  - (a) For real estate (item 1): deeds with legal descriptions and the latest lender's statement.
  - (b) For vehicles, boats, trailers (item 4): the title documents.
  - (c) For all bank accounts (item 5, 6, 7): the latest statement.
  - (d) For life insurance policies with cash surrender or loan value (item 10): the latest declaration page.
  - (e) For stocks, bonds, secured notes, mutual funds (item 11): the certificate or latest statement.
  - (f) For retirement and pensions (item 12): the latest summary plan document and latest benefit statement.
  - (g) For profit-sharing, IRAs, deferred compensation, and annuities (item 13): the latest statement.
  - (h) For each account receivable and unsecured note (item 14): documentation of the account receivable or note.
  - (i) For partnerships and other business interests (item 15): the most current K-1 and Schedule C.
  - (j) For other assets (item 16): the most current statement, title document, or declaration.
  - (k) For support arrearages (item 21): orders and statements.
  - (I) For credit cards and other debts (items 23 and 24): the latest statement.
- 3. Do not file copies of the above private financial documents with the court.

When filing a Property Declaration with the court, do not include private financial documents listed below.

#### Identify the type of declaration completed

- 1. Check "Community and Quasi-Community Property Declaration" on page 1 to use *Property Declaration* (form FL-160) to provide a combined list of community and quasi-community property assets and debts. Quasi-community property is property you own outside of California that would be community property if it were located in California.
- 2. Do not combine a separate property declaration with a community and quasi-community property declaration. Check "Separate Property Declaration" on page 1 when using *Property Declaration* to provide a list of separate property assets and debts.

#### **Description of the Property Declaration chart**

#### Pages 1 and 2

- 1. Column A is used to provide a brief description of each item of separate or community or quasi-community property.
- 2. Column B is used to list the date the item was acquired.
- 3. Column C is used to list the item's gross fair market value (an estimate of the amount of money you could get if you sold the item to another person through an advertisement).
- 4. Column D is used to list the amount owed on the item.
- 5. Column E is used to indicate the net fair market value of each item. The net fair market value is calculated by subtracting the dollar amount in column D from the amount in column C ("C minus D").
- 6. Column F is used to show a proposal on how to divide (or confirm) the item described in column A. Page 3
- 1. Column A is used to provide a brief description of each separate or community or quasi-community property debt.
- 2. Column B is used to list the date the debt was acquired.
- 3. Column C is used to list the total amount of money owed on the debt.
- 4. Column D is used to show a proposal on how to divide (or confirm) the item of debt described in column A.

#### When using this form only as an attachment to a *Petition* or *Response*

- 1. Attach a Separate Property Declaration (form FL-160) to respond to item 9. Only columns A and F on pages 1 and 2 and columns A and D on page 3 are required.

  - (d) For life insurance policies with cash surrender or loan value (item 10): the latest declaration page.
  - (e) For stocks, bonds, secured notes, mutual funds (item 11): the certificate or latest statement.
  - (f) For retirement and pensions (item 12): the latest summary plan document and latest benefit statement.
  - (g) For profit-sharing, IRAs, deferred compensation, and annuities (item 13): the latest statement.
  - (h) For each account receivable and unsecured note (item 14): documentation of the account receivable or note.
  - (i) For partnerships and other business interests (item 15): the most current K-1 and Schedule C.
  - (j) For other assets (item 16): the most current statement, title document, or declaration.
  - (k) For support arrearages (item 21): orders and statements.
  - (I) For credit cards and other debts (items 23 and 24): the latest statement.
- 3. Do not file copies of the above private financial documents with the court.
