## SUPERIOR COURT OF CALIFORNIA COUNTY OF SANTA CLARA <u>STANDING ORDER</u> FEES DUE FOR TRAFFIC CITATIONS

The Santa Clara County Superior Court has learned that the bail amount (in other words, the fees due) for some traffic citations is incorrectly stated on courtesy notices sent out by the Court. In some cases, the notices reflect an amount that is less than the actual amount due on the case. In other cases, the notices reflect an amount that is more than the actual amount due on the case.

Effective March 12, 2019:

 For cases in which the notices reflect an amount that is less than the actual amount due, the Court will accept the amount reflected on the notices as payment in full for the applicable violation(s).

2. For cases in which the notices reflect an amount that is more than the actual amount due, the Court will collect only the actual amount due for the applicable violation(s).
