COURT ORDER

15 GOOD CAUSE THEREFORE APPEARING, the Court hereby
16 authorizes the following agencies to act as a Family Wellness Court Team
17 (Wellness Team) for the Santa Clara County Family Wellness Court: the Santa
18 Clara County Social Services Agency, Office of the County Counsel, Domestic
19 Violence Intervention Collaborative (DVIC), Santa Clara County Office of
20 Education, Child Advocates of Silicon Valley, Department of Family and
21 Children's Services (DFCS), Department of Alcohol and Drug Services (DADS),
22 Department of Mental Health, Office of the District Attorney, Santa Clara Juvenile
23 Defenders, Superior Court's Dependency Division, and FIRST 5 Santa Clara
24 County to share verbal and written communication to serve the needs of each
25 parent and child that is enrolled in the Family Wellness Court. The purpose of the
26 Wellness Team is to engage in the best practices in the Dependency Court system
27 and to develop and improve services to our families and children in Santa Clara
28 County.

2 This Order is made on the following conditions:
3

- 4 1. The Agencies shall be bound by the confidentiality provisions of Welfare and
5 Institutions Code Sections 827 and 10850, and any information received shall
6 be used exclusively for the purpose described above.
- 7 2. The Agencies shall not publish, disseminate, or otherwise disclose, any
8 identifying information pertaining to any dependent child of the court.
- 9
10 3. The Agencies shall not publish any identifying information pertaining to any
11 placement of any dependent child of the court.
- 12 4. Each party over the age of 18 will sign a consent form to be in the
13 Family Wellness Court and will have knowledge of such Wellness Team
14 discussions to improve their Court outcomes.
- 15 5. Other Community Based Organization (CBO's) from time to time may
16 be present at the Wellness Team discussions and will also be bound by the
17 same Court Order. Those CBO's will be a necessary partner to improve the
18 outcome of the Court ordered service plan.
