

STANDING ORDER

PCI INVESTIGATORS


Pursuant to the authority vested in the Court pursuant to Welfare and Institution Code Section 827, and to further supplement the Court's Standing Order dated May 28, 2002 and Rule 3 of the Court's Juvenile Rules, Good Cause exists for the following Order:


In order to determine whether a minor in the Probate Court has a history as a Delinquent or a Dependent, Probate Court Investigators (PCI) shall have "view only" access to the Court's calendar management system for the limited purpose of determining whether there is a current or former Delinquency or Dependency case. An active Dependency case will result in a stay of the Guardianship case. The knowledge of an active Delinquency case will further the coordination between the Probate and Juvenile Court required under Welfare and Institutions Code Section 728 and California Rules of Court 5.815. Any information obtained may be referenced in the report to the Probate Court. Thereafter, all persons and parties to the Probate case are subject to Welfare and Institutions Code 827(a)(4)'s prohibition on further dissemination without authorization from the Juvenile Court.
