In order to help provide treatment, services, and supports to minors participating in the Santa Clara Court for the Individualized Treatment of Adolescents (CITA), the National Center for Youth Law (NCYL), and Legal Advocates for Children and Youths (LACY), and Bay Area Legal Aid (BALA), as members of the CITA Multidisciplinary Team, are hereby authorized to inspect and copy records maintained by the Juvenile Justice Court and other juvenile probation records maintained by the Santa Clara County Juvenile Probation Department.


NCYL, LACY and BALA may have advance copies of calendars from the court clerk's officer, so the offices may prepare in advance of court hearing dates.

Regarding all court and probation records received by NCYL, LACY and BALA these offices shall adhere to general confidential procedures for retention of records and destruction of records, as well as the terms of the Confidential Agreement and Memorandum of Understanding for CITA Multidisciplinary Team Members.

It is further ordered that NCYL, LACY and BALA may contact minors and / or their parents or guardians, following review of the minors' records, in order to coordinate the provision of civil legal services with their consent.

For each officer, this order shall be effective for the period during which they are members of the CITA Multidisciplinary Team.
