ORDER FOR RELEASE OF JUVENILE INFORMATION

The County of Santa Clara Department of Probation has established a Peer Court as an alternative to juvenile probation or other diversion programs. Peer Court is made up of teenagers from the community. It does not determine guilt or innocence; it only determines appropriate disposition. Participation is entirely voluntary. Information regarding juvenile offenders who choose to participate in Peer Court will be disclosed to those youth participating in the Peer Court Program. As some information to be disclosed may be confidential and protected from disclosure absent court order, the Court hereby authorizes Probation to disclose information regarding offending minors as necessary within the Peer Court program. The disclosure of information related to a participating minor is permitted under the following circumstances:

1. The minor and his/her parents/legal guardian who consent to participate in Peer Court must execute a Agreement and Waiver of Confidentiality and thereby agree, as a condition of participation, that information related to the minor will be disclosed during the Peer Court process.
2. All other individuals participating in Peer Court must agree, in writing, to maintain in confidence all information received in the Peer Court process regarding the offending minors.
