# PROUD PARENTING PROGRAM SERVICES FOR JUVENILE JUSTICE AND DEPENDENT YOUTH IN THE COMMUNITY Lezii Connelly

The court finds that there is a need for youthful parents (ages 14-17) supervised by the Juvenile Probation Department and the Department of Family and Children's Services to receive services under the Proud Parenting Program. These youth would benefit from prompt referral to Positive Parenting Program (Triple P) services, which utilize an evidence based curriculum.

## Based upon these findings, the court hereby makes the following Standing Order:

- 1. The Santa Clara Valley Health and Hospital System is hereby authorized to provide the following services to minors supervised by the Probation Department and/or the Department of Family & Children's Services:
  - (a) Process referrals for supervised minors via the Mental Health Call Center from the Juvenile Probation Department and the Department of Family of Children's Services.
  - (b) Conduct a mental health screening and assessment.
  - (c) Provide Triple P Services and/or provide referrals to the appropriate Triple P certified Community Based Organization to provide Triple P services.
- 2. The Juvenile Probation Department's probation officers and the Department of Family and Children's Services' social workers are authorized to sign necessary documentation and consent forms, for provision of the services set forth in Paragraph One above in accordance with their departmental procedures. Such authority shall not extend to a consent or other document the minor parent has the right to sign under applicable confidentiality and minor consent laws.

Only to the extent necessary to allow responsibility for payment to be determined and payment to be made for treatment rendered pursuant to this order, relevant information may be disclosed to any insurer, employer, health care service plan, hospital service plan, employee benefit plan, governmental authority administering governmental benefits, or any other person or entity responsible for paying for health care services rendered to the patient.
