7 The County of Santa Clara Department of Probation has agreed to permit filmmaker
8 Victoria Sutton Mills, Daniel Carter and VSM Productions, LLC, ("Victoria Mills") the ability to
9 enter the James Ranch (Ranch) for the purpose of filming a documentary on youth in the juvenile
10 justice system. For this purpose, Victoria Sutton Mills and Daniel Carter will be permitted to
11 enter the Ranch and film consenting juveniles. Participation is entirely voluntary. Information
12 regarding juvenile offenders who choose to participate in the filming of this documentary will be
13 disclosed to the filmmakers. The filmmakers intend to film images of the participating minors
14 while at the Ranch and these images will be publicly released.

15 As the information to be disclosed is confidential and protected from disclosure absent
16 court order, the Court hereby authorizes Probation to disclose information regarding offending
17 minors as necessary for purposes of filming the documentary. Also, Probation may permit
18 Victoria Sutton Mills and Daniel Carter to film consenting minors while at the Ranch. This
19 filming and the disclosure of information related to a participating minor are permitted under the
20 following circumstances:



- 22 1. The minor and his/her parents/legal guardian who consent to participate in filming of
23 documentary must execute an Agreement and Waiver of Confidentiality and thereby
24 agree, as a condition of participation, that their images while at the Ranch may be
25 publicly released and information related to the minor will be disclosed to the
26 filmmakers.
 - 27 2. The filmmakers are authorized to film the consenting minors but not any other minor
28 currently at the Ranch.
 3. All individuals participating in the filming of the documentary must agree, in writing,

to maintain in confidence all information received while filming regarding participating minors except as to its use in the film.
