ORDER

**FILMING OF PARTICIPANTS AT
STEM INTERNSHIP ROBOTICS CLASS**

It is hereby ordered that a film crew from NBC is authorized to film dependent youth who are participating in the STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Math) Internship Program Robotics Class, co-sponsored by TeenForce and the Silicon Valley Children's Fund. The filming is authorized on a one-time basis, and will occur on one Saturday between April 16, 2016 and May 21, 2016. The filming will occur on the Opportunity Youth Academy campus on Monterey Road in Gilroy, California. Youth who are 18 years of age or older may be interviewed, in addition to being filmed, provided they consent to being interviewed. No youth under the age of 18 can be interviewed.

It is also ordered that there will not be any direct shots of the faces of the youth, and the footage will not identify them as foster youth. The footage will be utilized by NBC as part of its coverage of Project Lead The Way's work in Santa Clara County, and particularly with the Silicon Valley Children's Fund.

This order expires on May 22, 2016.
