
**ORDER FOR ACCESS TO JUVENILE RECORDS**

Pursuant to federal and state laws, county social workers or county probation officers are required to ensure that a foster youth or non-minor dependents receive assistance with interpreting their consumer credit report and resolving any inaccuracies. The assistance may include, but is not limited to, referring the youth to a governmental or nonprofit agency that provides consumer credit services. ("Preventing Sex Trafficking and Strengthening Families Act" (P.L. 113-183); Welfare and Institutions Code §10618.6, and §16501.1)

In order to provide said consumer credit services and support to foster youth and non-minor dependents, Bay Area Legal Aid (BayLegal) is hereby authorized to inspect, copy, and receive the consumer credit report maintained by the Santa Clara County Juvenile Probation Department and/or Santa Clara County Department of Family and Children's Services for the limited purpose of assisting youth with consumer credit report inaccuracies.

BayLegal shall maintain the confidentiality of all records received at all times and shall retain and store these records according to the following policy: BayLegal shall adhere to the general confidential procedures for retention of records, retain client files for a minimum of five (5) years after case closure, and be destroyed thereafter.
