

**ORDER PERMITTING RELEASE OF MEDICAL RECORDS**

In order that juveniles who have been placed into custody by the Court in the Santa Clara County Probation Department's and Department of Family and Children's Services' temporary holding facilities (i.e. Shelter Care for Children such as the Santa Clara County Receiving and Intake Center- RAIC, Juvenile Hall, Juvenile Rehabilitation facilities, Emergency Satellite Homes, and alternative shelter programs) receive appropriate, necessary care of their physical and mental health, and in order to avoid endangering the health and welfare of other persons in these facilities, health care providers and schools are hereby authorized to provide to the Santa Clara Valley Medical Center clinics or the mental health guidance clinics rendering treatment to the juvenile the juvenile's immunization records and any other pertinent medical records necessary to determine what immediate care should be given to the juvenile. These records must be provided upon receipt of a copy of this standing order and a request for records from the applicable clinic providing care to the juvenile. These medical records are protected health information and clinics receiving these records are required by law to keep the information confidential.
