**STANDING ORDER AUTHORIZING FILMING AND PHOTOGRAPHY OF
DEPENDENT YOUTH AT THE 2ND ANNUAL FOSTER YOUTH GRADUATION
CELEBRATION**

It is hereby ordered that a film and photography crew for the Forty Niners Football Company LLC, and their agents, employees, and assigns (collectively, the "49ers"), can film and take photography of dependent youth who are participating in the 2nd Annual Foster Youth Graduation Celebration at the Levi's Stadium, in collaboration with Child Advocates ("CASA of Silicon Valley"), the Bill Wilson Center ("BWC"), and Pivotal.

The filming and photography are authorized on a one-time basis at the 2nd Annual Foster Youth Graduation Celebration that will occur on June 12, 2019. Participating youth include current and former foster youth who, in the 2018-2019 academic year, are graduating from High School, obtaining a GED, or earning a Vocational Program Certificate, Associate Degree, Bachelor's Degree, or Master's Degree. The filming and photography will occur at the Levi's Stadium located at 4900 Marie P. DeBartolo Way, Santa Clara, CA 95054. It is ordered that there will not be any direct shots of the faces of the youth. No dependent youth under the age of 18 can be interviewed. Dependent youth under the age of 18 who do not wish to be photographed shall not be photographed or filmed during this event. Dependent youth who are 18 years of age or older and who provide written consent may have direct shots taken and may have their name used. Dependent youth who are 18 years of age or older may be interviewed, in addition to being filmed and photographed, provided they consent to being interviewed.

The footage and photos may be utilized by the 49ers as part of its promotional coverage of the 2nd Annual Foster Youth Graduation Celebration. That coverage may include placing the footage on the 49ers webpage, on 49ers social media accounts (such as Facebook, Instagram, and Twitter), and providing to local news outlets. The footage will identify them as foster youth.

This order expires on June 30, 2020.
