SHOULD THIS OCCUR, THE ACCOUNTING UNIT OF THE PROBATION DEPARTMENT HAS THE STANDING AUTHORIZATION OF THE COURT TO REDUCE THE AMOUNT OF THE FINE IN QUESTION TO THE NEXT LOWEST DOLLAR FIGURE ON THE THEN CURRENT ASSESSMENT CHART WITHOUT FURTHER HEARING BEFORE THE COURT.
