RELEASE OF NAMES

With the passage of the Family Leave Act of 2004, foster parents now have the opportunity to receive disability insurance payments for six weeks a year. In order to ensure that foster parents receive these benefits, the court hereby permits foster family agencies and other entities operating foster homes to release the names of a foster child to a human resource department or other entity that requires the name of the foster child in order to process disability insurance payments to foster parents.

This Order shall be limited to the purpose of ensuring that foster parents receive the benefits they are entitled to under the Family Leave Act.
