JUVENILE COURT DIVISION STANDING ORDER

The Girl Scouts of Northern California ("Girl Scouts") provides leadership training classes for youth supervised by the County of Santa Clara's Probation Department and housed at Juvenile Hall and the William F. James Ranch ("Ranch"). The Girl Scouts would like to make and publicize a video highlighting its services at the Ranch. This Order permits the Girls Scouts to film at the Ranch.

Any youth who participates in audio or video recording or still photography for this purpose must separately provide informed written consent to the Juvenile Probation Department prior to their participation. If the youth is represented by counsel, the youth's attorney must be notified of the proposed participation before the youth provides consent. The County of Santa Clara will ensure that no youth's face is visible in the resulting material and will take other appropriate steps to preserve youth confidentiality.

The terms of this standing order will expire on July 1, 2026.
