JUVENILE COURT DIVISION STANDING ORDER

The County of Santa Clara's Probation and Custody Health Departments were selected as recipients of the California State Association of Counties' "Challenge Award" in recognition of their peer health education program. The County would like to highlight the award-winning program in video media. This Order permits County of Santa Clara staff to film in William F. James Juvenile Rehabilitation Facility (Ranch) and the Santa Clara County Juvenile Hall Facility.

Any youth who participates in audio or video recording or still photography for this purpose must separately provide informed written consent to the Juvenile Probation Department prior to their participation. If the youth is represented by counsel, the youth's attorney must be notified of the proposed participation before the youth provides consent. The County will ensure that no youth's face is visible in the resulting material and will take other appropriate steps to preserve youth confidentiality.

The terms of this standing order will expire on December 31, 2026.
