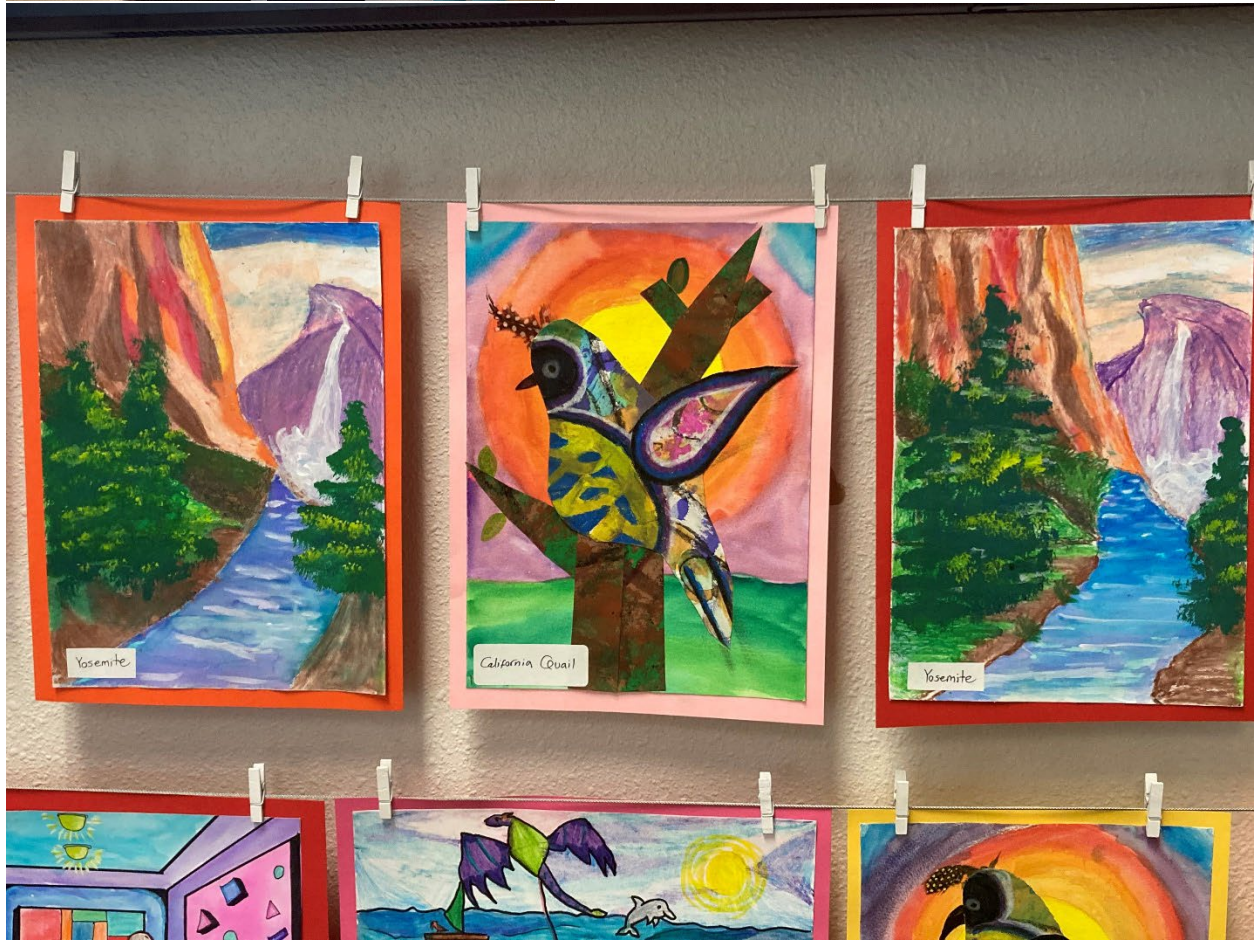
On Thursday, July 11, 2024, students, parents, educators, community members, and judicial officers came together to celebrate the achievements of 200 budding artists.

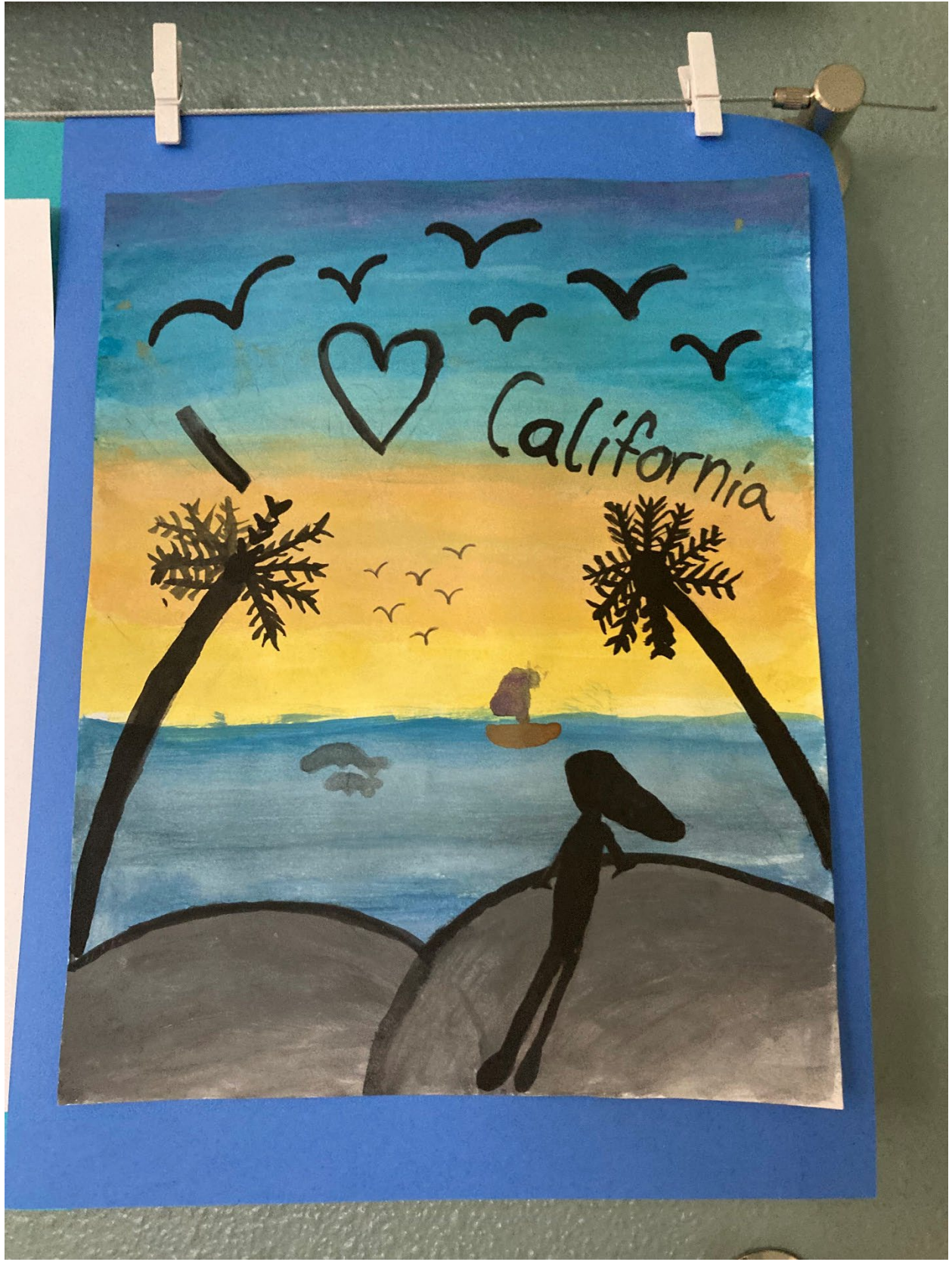

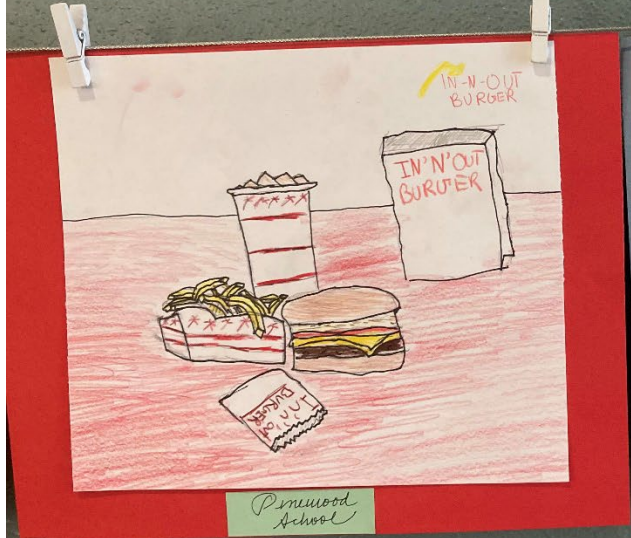

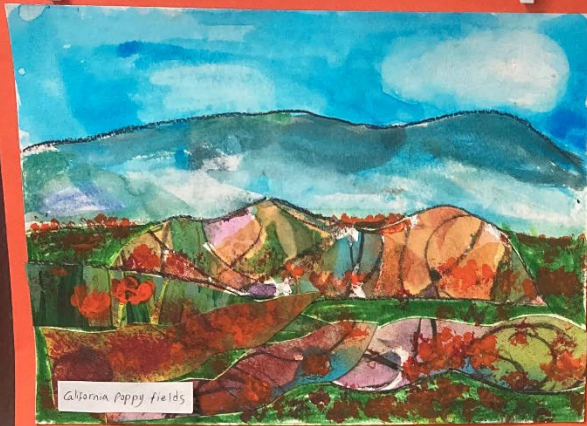
