Santa Clara County's Civil Grand Jury Releases Report

Police and the Mentally III: Improving Outcomes

SAN JOSÉ, Calif. (May 9, 2018): The Superior Court of California, County of Santa Clara announces the release the Civil Grand Jury's Report: Police and the Mentally III: Improving Outcomes.

Nearly one-third of police shootings in Santa Clara County arise from encounters with someone in a mental-health crisis. In nine of the 31 fatal shootings by law enforcement officers in the past five years, mental illness was a primary factor.

The Grand Jury analyzed crisis intervention training offered by every lawenforcement agency in the county.

The Grand Jury recommends all law enforcement officers receive additional crisis intervention and de-escalation training to prepare officers to deal with people who are behaving irrationally. Training should include role-playing video simulations.

The Grand Jury also recommends that the county deploy additional mobile crisis intervention teams staffed by mental-health professionals.
