Finding 7: The San José Unified School District did not have a parcel tax in place when the Grand Jury concluded its data collection and was thus not included in the calculations nor in other Findings and Recommendations.

· Agree as San José Unified did not have a parcel tax during the Grand Jury's investigation.

Recommendation 7: In anticipation of the assessment of the \$72 parcel tax with a senior exemption, the San José Unified School District should implement the following. Recommendations in the report: 1a, 1b, 1c, 3a, 3b, 4, 5, 6, and 9b.

- Recommendation 1a has been implemented as information about the parcel tax was available through a variety of means other than the Internet.
- * Recommendation 1b has been implemented as there is a link on the home page of the district's website that includes the words "parcel tax".
- * Recommendation 1c has been implemented as the "parcel tax" link on the home page of the district's website leads to the exemption application procedures and forms.
- * Recommendation 3a has been implemented as parcel tax exemption applicants can apply by mail without making a special request,
- Recommendation 3b has been implemented as requests for parcel tax exemptions may be submitted electronically, without the need to apply in person or by traditional mail.
- * Recommendation 4 has been implemented as exemption application forms for the parcel tax are available year round.
- * Recommendation 5 will not be implemented because it is not reasonable as San José Unified has no authority over other locally elected governing boards.
- * Recommendation 6 has been implemented as renewals are not required unless the Office of the Assessor records a change in ownership for the specific property.
- Recommendation 9b will not be implemented because it is not reasonable as San José
 Unified has no authority to standardize the processes of other governing boards.
