You may purchase certified copies of your signed decree for additional cost.

### WHAT DO I DO AFTER I GET THE MINOR'S NAME AND GENDER CHANGE DECREE?

You may want to amend their birth record with their new name and gender. To do this, contact the Office of Vital Records if they were born in California. You can get more information at <a href="http://www.cdph.ca.gov">http://www.cdph.ca.gov</a>.

If they weren't born in California, check with the Office of Vital Records in the State where they were born.
