#### WHAT DO I DO AFTER I GET MY NAME CHANGE DECREE?

You may want to amend your birth record with your new name. To do this, contact the Office of Vital Records if you were born in California. If you weren't born in California, check with the Office of Vital Records in the State where you were born.
